With this mission the student council for the year 2015-16 was nominated in the month of June and on the inaugural day, in the presence of Prof. Uma Maheshwar Rao, Registrar Andhra University as the chief guest for the day and other dignitaries, staff and students, our principal Dr. Sr. Shyji handed over the badges to the office bearers and congratulated them highlighting the role of the student council. - C. The First Years (Semester II) had to individually design a flow chart very creatively for a particular activity of One Module (in the class) and it was really wonderful how they used details and symbols to come up with a great output.
- D. The Second Years (III Semester) as part of Business Accounting studied some Final Accounts of firms (which were procured rather confidentially) and were analysed by them to understand them better.
- E. The Second Years (IV Semester) as part of Gender Studies, did Poster presentations individually along with Presentations on 'Women who influence people's lives' followed by vibrant discussions among the class, which were argumentative yet conclusive.
- F. The Third Years (Semester V) did **Role Plays of Managers** (CEOs, VPs & AVPs) as part of Managerial Skills and it was video shot and later the Videos were played for a thorough analysis on the learning and how it could have been better. This is rather **Micro Learning** in Educational training courses like BEd.
- G. The Third Years (Semester V) did an **Individual SWOT Analysis** among other techniques as part of Career and Employment Training Paper which made them have an accurate analysis of themselves to prepare their CV.
- H. The Third Years (Semester VI) as part of Business Communication using the **Jigsaw Classroom technique** where each segment of Communication styles & Process of Communication and a Full case was given to different groups consisting of diverse students (in terms of level of understanding and language competencies), Each group (segment) consisting of the leader who was more of an expert in the area presented their part to the class and the others could ask questions for clarification. At the end all the groups had a quick quiz for feedback of understanding the topic and analyzing the case.
- I. The Third Years (Semester VI) as part of Web Advertising had to submit an **Online Assignment (Paper in Ms Word or PPT) within a limited time (6 hours)** and the first three entries got bonus marks. Since the data for the Assignments were accessed from the Internet they were assessed by a set of criteria to eliminate cut, copy and paste and be original.
- J. All the Three Year students were successful when we used **Mind Mapping** especially for learning something new and trying to find the connections and map using symbols and signs to connect with what they already know and it had good payoffs.

K. **Elaborative interrogation or learning** method which involved concentrating on the 'Why' questions to be introduced or prior knowledge rather than 'What' questions was effective for all the years as it took them to a higher level of application and synthesis (except a few students). It was found excellent for higher learners and for learners with experience in a particular area and even the others started thinking on those lines. It was effective for any class in any Paper many a time as it made them 'think out of the box'.
