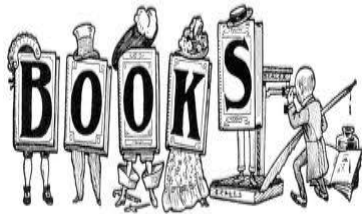

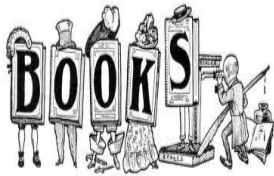

Genesis of STULIB:

The STULIB (Student Library) was started in 2009 to create more awareness among students about books and their impact on our personality and life. Being a book lover the number of books that were in the personal library of Ms. Ramani Dhanaraj were compiled to create STULIB in the Department of Office Management, St. Joseph's College for Women (Autonomous) with around 383 books originally. Outstanding features of STULIB are

- 📖 It is managed by the students (regular issue)
- 📖 There is a Stock register which contains the inventory of books
- 📖 There is a books forum where students discuss books
- 📖 With a minimum contribution, even magazines were shared and discussed
- 📖 It motivates students to read more books
