### Learning Outcomes

After completion of the course students will be able to

#### **I Semester LF=1004 (3)**

- Become aware of another different culture, the sound of the French language, certain words in French and some famous French symbols/landmarks.
- Understand basic classroom instructions.
- Conduct simple conversations on such topics as: common greetings; friends and families; food and drink; and times of day.
- introduce themselves, can tell age, birthday, nationality and where they live and ask others about their names, ages and nationalities etc.

#### **II Semester LF=2004(3)**

- Use different forms of address to speak to friends, teachers and people using formal and informal modes of address and language.
- Read and demonstrate comprehension of a short paragraph in French about other people, places or everyday topics.
- achieve cultural competency through living in another cultural and linguistic environment.
- understand simple texts providing personal details of others.

#### **III Semester LF=3004 (3)**

- understand when the teacher is speaking to one or more persons in class and understand simple commands (mostly passive, receptive language with some active, productive language) and polite language. I can recognise 'tu' and 'vous' forms and help phrases such as '*Pardon*', '*s'il vous plaît*', '*excusez-moi*', '*merci*'.
- write a short introduction about myself, providing personal details and use simple connectors, such as '*et*', '*mais*' and '*aussi*'.
- Write a 5-10 sentence paragraph in French about themselves and everyday topics.
