The following resolutions were adopted.

1. As per the UGC new guidelines and also suggestions made by Autonomy Review Committee, it was decided to shift grading system from 5 point scale to 10 point scale.
2. Dr. P. Bhushanavathi from the department of chemistry recommended as controller of exam and entrusted to prepare complete examination manual incorporating all the rules and regulations for the effective conduct of examinations.

5. To allot 5% / 10% marks for attendance improve regularity of students (including foundation courses)
6. To introduce on line mode of examination to prepare students for the future computer examinations (II mid semester examinations)
7. To conduct all core papers end semester examinations for 3 hrs with 60 marks weightage and foundation course papers for 2 hrs with 50 marks weightage
8. Splitting of 40% marks of CA as follows (core papers MSE-I - 15% MSE-II - 15% Accessory Assessment - 5% Attendance - 5% ~~Practical~~ foundation course papers MSE-I - 30% & Attendance 10% Practical assessment - No change
9. Allotment of marks for attendance as follows <75% - 0 marks, 75% - <80% - 1, 80% - <85% - 2, 85% - <90% - 3, 90% - <95% - 4, 95% - 100% - 5
