ST JOSEPH'S COLLEGE FOR WOMEN (AUTONOMOUS) VISAKHAPATNAM DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE

The Department of Political Sciences Joseph's College for women (A), seeks to serve B.A. Program, students interested in careers related to Political Science. The department offers Political Science in two core combinations HEP (Telugu Medium) and EEP (English medium). In order to cater to the diverse interests of students and employers, a total of 7 theory papers are offered as part of Political Science in the two combinations.

PSO1. Be able to gain basic knowledge in the core areas of political science (Concepts, Theories and Institutions, Political Thought, Administration and Management)

ASSESSMENT METHODOLOGY: Direct method of computing PSO1 attainment based on the student performance in all assessment instruments namely, online and offline –subjective and objective tests for all the courses offered. (POL1501, POL2501, POL3501, POL4501, POL5501, POL5502, POL6501). These exams test the students learning knowledge, understanding and application levels in the respective courses.

Indirect method of computing PSO is done through students course exist survey wherein a structured questionnaire is administered to the students and their response is solicited on a 5 point scale. Responses are consolidated and student satisfaction level with reference to course transactions is computed.

Assessment of all the theory courses is done in two parts, namely by formative assessment 40%) which is internal and summative assessment 60% is external. Mid semester examination 15% (which is offline), 15% mid semester is online. Accessory assessment is for 5% (written quiz, assignments, news report survey), attendance 5% (above 75% attendance will be rewarded). End Semester examination 60% (which is descriptive).

Level of attainment in all the theory courses offered by the department: Average Percentage of level of attainment of all the courses in Political Science is given below.

81+78+78.35+81.5+75.5+79+92.5% = 80.84%.

PSO assessment of the students is done through collecting material from books and internet and submission of assignment as accessory test 5%.
